Job Description:

Employee will be responsible for outreach and technical support to property owners and organizations to promote the use of small-scale stormwater runoff control on residential and commercial properties. Selected individual will work in a team environment with other staff and external groups to conduct field evaluations and develop site-specific recommendations for small-scale runoff control practices, including but not limited to rain gardens, rain barrels, cisterns, conservation landscaping, and pervious for impervious replacement. Working in a team environment, the individual will refine incentive program elements; maintain a database on project locations, contacts, expenditures and other related information; and identify and track performance measures to document environmental benefits associated with program implementation. This employee will work with other staff to design and conduct effective training workshops to educate and solicit program participants. The employee will also generate newsletters, website materials or other watershed outreach to community groups and individuals. The employee will be expected to develop and administer contracts and grants as necessary to support work program responsibilities.

Minimum Qualifications:

Bachelor's Degree in environmental outreach and education, natural resources management, or related environmental field.

Considerable three (3) years experience in planning and implementing environmental outreach efforts using on-site, low-impact design (LID) stormwater management techniques.

An equivalent combination of education or experience may be substituted.

Preferred Criteria:

4. Experience developing and presenting technical information in public workshops and community meeting settings.

5. Experience developing and administering contracts and grants.

If selected for consideration for this position, you may be required to provide evidence that you possess the knowledge, skills, and abilities indicated on your resume.
